

What is the Trinsic Single Scorecard?

The Single Scorecard is how Trinsic helps practices focus on the work that leads to success in our value-based contracts. It is developed by our Clinical Committee and approved by our Board. How your practice group performs on the scorecard ultimately affects the amount of shared savings that practice group receives.



ENGAGEMENT

16% of score

Focuses on network physicians/ APPs and care-team engagement.



CAPABILITIES

28% of score

Focuses on appropriate annual visits and implementing office processes needed to support value-based care.



CLINICAL CARE

28% of score

Focuses on clinical quality metrics that emphasize prevention and chronic disease management and are measures common across our payer contracts.



COST

28% of score

Focuses on utilization measures that have significant impact on the total cost of care.
